


BONNINGTON MAINS QUARRY

THE DEVELOPMENT



INFILLING

It is proposed to infill the quarry void with the clay/silt by-product generated by the Materials Recycling Plant. This operation would be undertaken progressively, starting in the northeastern side of the site and progressing in a southwestern direction.

The early stages of infilling of the quarry void would be undertaken during the latter stages of the mineral extraction operations associated with the quarry.

RESTORATION

The site would be progressively restored, and upon completion of infilling operations, the site would be returned to productive agricultural grassland, incorporating woodland planting, hedgerows and wetland areas.



HOURS OF OPERATION

No changes will be sought to the hours of operations granted through planning permissions 22/02513/FUL & 22/02514/FUL. The recycling and infilling operations would be undertaken at the same time as the ongoing quarry operations, which are as follows;

Monday - Saturday: 07:00 - 19:00

DURATION OF OPERATIONS

No change is sought to the duration of operations, which currently allows operations to continue to 3rd September 2050 and final restoration to be completed by 3rd September 2052.
