Thank you for your letter dated 21 August 2023. We have reviewed the dust impact assessment supplied by SLR Consulting Limited (14/07/23) and would re-iterate our previous comments made (letter dated 07/07/2022) in particular the following;

There is little actual assessment of the impact on local air quality. The applicant has suggested that tree planting and creation of bunds along the site boundary will help reduce impact of dust on the local area. However, without actual data to support this, we cannot agree with this statement. We recommend that the Regulator confirm that they satisfied with this approach, or if not to recommend a more detailed air quality assessment.

We note that the additional noise assessment supplied by SLR Consulting Limited (02/08/23) provides an environmental noise survey, the results of which conclude that predicted noise emissions will not exceed the recommended limits for the various Phase of operation at all of the identified noise sensitive locations with the exception of Bryn Neffyd (+1.3dB). The assessment has assumed a worst case scenario whereby all plant is operating 100% of the time.

In view of the proximity of the nearest residents, the Regulator should satisfy themselves that defined noise controls are adequate to ensure the site does not give rise to nuisance are residential receptor locations, and that any complaints are investigated and where necessary remedial actions are taken.
